**Introducer:** The Conard-Pyle Co.

**Breeder:** Nevin Smith/Suncrest Nurseries

**Type:** Interspecific Hybrid Salvia

**Hardiness:** USDA zones 7-11.

**Growth Habit/Form:** Tall and bushy. May approach 3 feet tall by 4 feet wide.

**Flowers:** Bright pink to salmon bicolor. Blooms continuously from May to September.

**Foliage:** Light green with good disease resistance.

**Vegetation:** Very bushy and upright

**Soil (pH):** Does not like heavy, wet ground. Avoid overwatering.

**Sun/Shade:** Full sun

**Special Features:** The second variety in a new series of hybrid Salvias. 'Shell Dancer' is less susceptible to breakage than other hybrids on the market. It has proven to be very vigorous and a prolific bloomer. Performs well in hot, dry climates. The salmon/pink flowers attract Hummingbirds.

**Uses:** Perennial borders or dryland rock gardens. Cut back above new new growth at the end of the winter to keep it compact.
