**Origin:** Bred by Nevin Smith/Suncrest Nurseries. Introduced by The Conard-Pyle Co.

### INFORMATION

**Hardiness:** USDA Zones 7-11. Full hardiness testing is underway.

**Size:** May approach 3' high x 4' wide.

**Growth Habit/Form:** Tall and bushy.

**Flowers:** Bright pink to salmon bicolor. Blooms continuously from May to September.

**Vegetation:** Very bushy and upright

**Foliage:** TLight green with good disease resistance.

**Soil (pH):** Does not like heavy,wet ground. Avoid overwatering.

**Sun/Shade:** Full sun.

**Pruning/Shearing:** May be sheared back mid season to encourage more uniform flowering and a more compact habit

**Propagation Notes:** Easily propagated by softwood cuttings.
