## INFORMATION

**Origin:** Andre Briant Jeunes Plants; Angers, France.

**Hardiness:** USDA Cold Hardiness Zone 4-7. AHS Heat Tolerance Zone 6-10.

**Size:** 12-18" tall x 18-24" wide.

**Growth Habit/Form:** Low growing, spreading, very bushy, overall procumbent.

**Flowers:** Flowers June to September (not ornamentally significant).

**Fruit:** Up to ½ inch rounded berries are born on the stem tips. The pinkish-purple berries hold on thru late November. Ornamental only.

**Foliage:** Golden yellow with orange new growth, very stable and some burn in full sun. Foliage color is more lime green if grown in shade. Deciduous.

**Soil (pH):** Moist well drained soil.

**Sun/Shade:** Full sun to partial shade. Foliage will be more green in the shade.

**Pruning/Shearing:** For best results, cut back to around 10" from the ground in late winter or early spring.

**Propagation Notes:** Asexual propagation of this protected variety is prohibited without a license. Vegetative softwood cuttings or hardwood cuttings.

**Special Features:** Useful as a ground cover; does not become invasive. Golden foliage and low habit.

**Uses:** Shrub border, mass plantings in tough areas. Use for erosion control on open slopes or as a ground cover.

**Availability:** The Conard-Pyle Co. as finished plants.
