ORIGIN

Origin: Cobalt radiated seedling of Forsythia x. intermedia 'Spring Glory.'

INFORMATION

Hardiness: USDA Zone 4-9.

Size: 2 ½-3' wide x 2 ½-4' tall

Growth Habit/Form: Wide prostrate growth habit.

Flowers: Golden yellow clusters of blooms in early Spring.

Fruit: Of no ornamental significance.

Foliage: Grass green, serrate, lanceolate with deep burgundy Fall color.

Soil (pH): Prefers loose soil, but will take any soil conditions.

Sun/Shade: Full sun to maximize flower production.

Pruning/Shearing: Prune after flowering in spring, takes shearing.

Propagation Notes: Roots easily from soft to semi-hardwood cuttings taken Summer through Fall.

Special Features: Exhibits wide prostrate growth habit, bears anthocyanin coloration at the apex of the sepals, forms attractive dense wide-opening yellow flowers that commonly are singly borne per bud, and is slow-growing and requires no special care.

Uses: Attractive wide and low-growing ornamental spring-flowering shrub for growing in pots, tubs or containers in small gardens, balconies and terraces. Alternatively can be grown in the landscape. Requires no special care.
