DESCRIPTION

THE BUD

Form: Ovoid
Color: Deep pink suffused with cream white on the outside and reddish pink with cream yellow at the base on the outside of the petal
Size: Medium

THE BLOOM

Color: Magenta red to light Pink with yellow center on the inside and deep pink changing to white towards the center on the outside of the petal
Form: Cuplike, semi double
Number of Petals: 12 to 15 on average
Size: Medium
Diameter: 2 ½" on average
Fragrance: None noticeable, however the petioles emit the distinctive sweet smell of the Moss roses when slightly pressed between the fingers.

THE PLANT

Vegetation: Very Vigorous
Habit: Climbing
Inflorescence: Usually 3 to 8 flowers per stem
Foliage: Green, semi-glossy
Disease Tolerance: Excellent
Flowering: Abundant and continuous
Height: Up to 10'
